Brief Itinerary:

Day 1: Monday, November 4 or 11, 2024 (MBS, D)

We will depart this morning for our Nashville adventure, beginning with a stop for our signature breakfast to-go bag. The majority of this day will be spent driving to Nashville, stopping for dinner at Paula Deen's Family Kitchen upon arrival. Following dinner, we'll be joined by a successful local songwriter. He'll play some of the hit songs he's written and answer questions about the recording industry before we check into our hotel for the night.

Day 2: Tuesday, November 5 or 12, 2024 (CB, D)

This morning will begin with a hot breakfast at our hotel before we head to our professionally guided tour of Nashville. Following the tour, you will have time to explore the historic 2nd Avenue (downtown Nashville) for shopping and lunch on your own. Dinner this evening will take place at the Santa Fe Cattle Company, famous for their delicious food, made from scratch and served in a comfortable, fun atmosphere.
