

## Itinerary-

### Day 1, June 8, 2025 - Sunday - D

We'll depart Baldwin Street Middle School at 5:00 am this morning for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We will stop at the Cleveland Zoo to eat our sack lunch and stretch our legs before heading to our hotel in Albany, New York.

### Day 2, June 9, 2025 - Monday - CB, L, & D

Today, we spend time seeing some of the great sights of Boston. We start with lunch at Faneuil Hall before we board the "Duck", a W.W.II-style, amphibious landing vehicle, and we cruise by all the places that make Boston the Birthplace of Freedom. Next, we will learn of the famous event that forever changed the course of American history at the Boston Tea Party Ships and Museum. Our dinner will be at the Fire & Ice Grill, where you choose your own ingredients and then watch their Grill Chefs create your meal on the world's largest grill. We then head south towards New York City, staying in Milford, CT for the night.

### Day 3, June 10, 2025 - Tuesday - CB, L, & D

This is a day of exploring the "Big Apple". Our morning will start with a boat ride out to see the Statue of Liberty up close. We then grab a box lunch and take a double decker bus ride down to the 9/11 Reflecting Pools. We will visit One World Observatory, where we will take a 60-second elevator ride to the 100th floor, for breathtaking views of NYC, then we explore Times Square, with dinner at Hard Rock Cafe, before heading out for Washington D.C..

### Day 4, June 11, 2025 - Wednesday - CB, L, & D

We'll spend all day exploring Washington D.C., with time to explore the Smithsonian Museums. We then test our spy skills at the International Spy Museum. Our dinner will be at Uno Pizzeria before heading to our hotel for the night.

### Day 5, June 12, 2025 - Thursday - CB, L, & D

This morning will start with a guided tour of some of the memorials in our nation's capitol before heading to Gettysburg. Once there, we will have lunch, and shopping time before visiting the Shriver House. Our dinner will be at the Farmhouse Restaurant at The Barn Resort, followed by a guided tour of Gettysburg National Military Park, before we check into our hotel for the night.

### Day 6, June 13, 2025 - Friday - CB, L, & D

The morning will be spent at the Visitor Center where we will see the Cyclorama and the movie "A New Birth of Freedom" before heading to Hershey Park for the afternoon & evening. Afterwards, we will re-board our motorcoach and head for home.

We will arrive back in Hudsonville around 8:00 am.

**Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments:** Reservations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis with a deposit of \$100.00 made payable to Countryside Tours, Inc. Reservation coupon and check must be sent to Countryside Tours, Inc., P.O. Box 48, Sand Lake, Michigan 49343-0048. Final payment will be due on, or prior to, March 31, 2025. Late payments will be assessed a penalty of \$25.00.

**Insufficient Fund Checks:** There will be a \$30.00 charge for checks with insufficient funds.

**Tour Cost:** The tour cost as advertised in this brochure is based on current costs and tariffs in effect at the time of printing. Should these change, an adjustment (either way) will result. If the advertised tour cost is increased by more than 5%, you may cancel within 10 days of notification and receive a full refund.

**Cancellations and Refunds:** Cancellations MUST be made in writing (email is acceptable) to our office. For cancellations on or prior to the March payment deadline there will be a full refund less an administrative fee of \$50.00.
