Brief Itinerary

Day 1: Sunday, December 1 (B, D)

We will board the motorcoach this morning, and head for Lewisburg, PA, where we will spend the night. Along the way, we will stop for our signature breakfast, and lunch (on your own). Dinner will be included this evening at La Primavera restaurant.

Day 2: Monday, December 2 (B)

Today we are NYC bound! After breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for the Big Apple! We will stop for lunch (on your own) along the way. We will arrive in New York City in the afternoon, and check into The Jewel NYC, where we will stay for three nights. In the evening, dinner will be on your own before we tour Radio City Music Hall, and then find our fantastic seats for The Rockettes Christmas Spectacular!

Day 3 & 4: Tuesday, December 3 and Wednesday, December 4

Experience New York City your way, with these two days on your own. If you are looking for suggestions, need help to find attractions or tickets to shows, we will do our best to help you! We want you to have a fabulous experience!

Day 5: Thursday, December 5
