### Day 1 - June 8, 2025 - Sunday - D

We'll depart Grant Middle School at 5:30 am for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We will make a stop and learn of the heroic actions of the passengers and crew at the Flight 93 National Memorial on our way to Gettysburg.

### Day 2 - June 9, 2025 - Monday - CB, L, & D
