

Itinerary-

Day 1 - June 7, 2025 - Saturday - D

We'll depart Riley Street Middle School at 6:30 am this morning for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We will make a stop and learn of the heroic actions of the passengers and crew at the Flight 93 National Memorial, on our way to Gettysburg.

Day 2 - June 8, 2025 - Sunday - CB, L, & D

We will start the morning off with a tour of Gettysburg National Military Park with a Park Service Guide. Then we tour the Shriver House, where we will learn what it was like being a civilian during the Battle of Gettysburg. After lunch we will head for Washington D.C.. We will take a guided tour of the nations memorials before heading to our hotel for the night.

Day 3 - June 9, 2025 - Monday - CB, L, & D

Today we will continue our exploration of Washington D.C.. We start with a tram ride through Arlington Cemetery to witness the Changing of the Guard Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Our afternoon will be spent visiting some Smithsonian Museums. We will have dinner on our way to Philadelphia for the night.

Day 4 - June 10, 2025 - Tuesday - B, L, & D

After breakfast at Hard Rock Cafe, we will ride a double-decker bus through the historic streets of Philadelphia. We will walk around Independence Hall and the Liberty Bell before visiting the Eastern State Penitentiary, where some of America's most notorious criminals were held. We then head out for New York City. Once in the city we will have dinner then we walk over to One World Observatory, where we will take a 60-second elevator ride to the 100th floor, for breathtaking views of NYC.

Day 5 - June 11, 2025 - Wednesday - CB, L, & D

We start our morning with some shopping time, lunch, and a visit to Madame Tussauds in Times Square. We then take a heart stopping thrill ride on a 70-foot speedboat called The Beast out to see the Statue of Liberty. We have dinner at Bubba Gump, then we head over to watch the unique theatrical experience, "The Blue Man Group", before heading back to our hotel for the night.

Day 6 - June 12, 2025 - Thursday - CB, L, & D

We will depart our hotel in the morning for Hershey Park. This afternoon and evening, we'll enjoy the amusement rides at Hershey Park! Afterwards, we will reboard our motorcoach and head for home.

We arrive back to Riley Street Middle School at approximately 8:00 am

Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments: Reservations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis with a deposit of \$100.00 made payable to Countryside Tours, Inc. Reservation coupon and check must be sent to Countryside Tours, Inc., P.O. Box 48, Sand Lake, Michigan 49343-0048. Final payment will be due on, or prior to, March 31, 2025. Late payments will be assessed a penalty of \$25.00.

Insufficient Fund Checks: There will be a \$30.00 charge for checks with insufficient funds.

Tour Cost: The tour cost as advertised in this brochure is based on current costs and tariffs in effect at the time of printing. Should these change, an adjustment (either way) will result. If the advertised tour cost is increased by more than 5%, you may cancel within 10 days of notification and receive a full refund.

Cancellations and Refunds: Cancellations MUST be made in writing (email is acceptable) to our office. For cancellations on or prior to the March payment deadline there will be a full refund less an administrative fee of \$50.00. For cancellations received after that date there will be no refund of the \$100.00 deposit. No-shows for your Spring Mandatory Meeting (without permission) will be dropped from the tour and the deposit will be forfeited. Cancellations after the March payment deadline are as follows: Cancellations received 30 days before the trip date will receive a 50% refund; Cancellations received 14 days before the trip date will receive a 25% refund; Cancellations received seven days before the trip or no-shows will receive no refund.

Broadway Theater Tickets: If your school's itinerary includes Broadway Theater Tickets, the cost of the ticket will be non-refundable after February 28, 2025.
