

## Itinerary-

### Day 1 - June 10, 2026 - Wednesday - D

We'll depart Our Lady of Consolation school parking lot at 5:30 am this morning for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We'll travel through Canada to Niagara Falls, and take a boat ride out to view the spectacular falls. Our first night will be spent in Albany, New York.

### Day 2 - June 11, 2026 - Thursday - CB, L, & D

An early start this morning will find us heading east to Boston. After lunch at Quincy Market Place we take a tour of the famous Fenway Park, home of the Boston Red Sox. We then board the "Duck", a W.W.II-style, amphibious landing vehicle, and cruise by all places that make Boston the Birthplace of Freedom. Our dinner will be at the Fire & Ice Grill, where you choose your own ingredients and then watch their Grill Chefs create your meal on the world's largest grill. We then head south towards New York City, staying in Milford, CT for the night.

### Day 3 - June 12, 2026 - Friday - CB, L, & D

This is a day of exploring the "Big Apple". We start with some shopping time, and lunch in Times Square before visiting Madame Tussauds. Then we take heart-stopping thrill ride on a 70-foot speedboat, called The Beast, out to view the Statue of Liberty. We will have dinner on our way to hotel as we head south for Washington D.C..

### Day 4 - June 13, 2026 - Saturday - CB, L, & D

We will depart for Washington D.C. to spend the afternoon exploring the Smithsonian Museums. After some dinner we will take a guided tour of our nation's memorials before heading to our hotel for the night.

### Day 5 - June 14, 2026 - Sunday - CB, L, & D

After breakfast at the hotel we will take a tram ride through Arlington Cemetery for the Changing of the Guard Ceremony. We will have time for lunch and shopping at the Fashion Centre at Pentagon City Mall before we head for Gettysburg. We will take a guided tour of the Battlefield before dinner, and then head to our hotel for the night.

### Day 6 - June 15, 2026 - Monday - CB, L, & D

This morning we will visit the Shriver House, where we will learn what it was like to be a civilian during the Battle of Gettysburg. Then we are off to spend the afternoon and evening at Hershey Park with amusement rides and a water park. Afterward, we will reboard our motorcoach and head for home.

### Day 7 - June 16, 2026 - Tuesday

We will arrive back in West Michigan around 8:30 am.
