Day 1 - May 14, 2026 - Thursday - L & D

We'll depart Triumph Academy parking lot at 6:00 am this morning for our exciting trip to Mackinac Island! We will arrive in Mackinaw City in time for lunch and a little shopping before visiting Old Mackinac Point Lighthouse. We then head over to explore Mills Creek Discovery Park. After dinner, our evening will be spent watching some lumberjacks demonstrate skills such as chopping, sawing, axe throwing, cross-cut sawing, and logrolling at the Jack Pine Lumberjack Show. After the show, we will head to the hotel for the night.

Day 2 - May 15, 2026 - Friday - CB, L, & D

After breakfast at the hotel, we start our morning off with a ferry ride to Mackinac Island! First we take a guided tour of the Fort Mackinac. Next is a visit to the beautiful Butterfly House, where we will enjoy the first of its kind in Michigan, and the third oldest LIVE butterfly exhibit in the United States. Afterwards, we will have some lunch and shopping on the island, before touring the Island on horse drawn carriages. We then board the boat to St. Ignace, for a drive over the Might Mac before heading for home.
