Reservations & Payment Schedule:

Single-day tours \$199 and under: full payment is due at time of reservation.

Single-day tours \$200+: \$100 deposit, final payment due 45 days prior to tour.

Multi-day tours: \$100 deposit due at reservation, 50% of balance is due 90 days prior to the tour, with final payment due 45 days prior the tour.

Tours may require a larger deposit due to tour expenses and will be noted on the brochure.

Deposits are non refundable. Payments become non-refundable upon due dates. Travelers can fill their vacancy or forfeit their monies. In the event of a cancelation, both of the travelers must contact the office to fill a vacancy.

Reservations can may be at online, by phone, or with the reservation coupon. Deposits are due at the time of reservation. Your reservation is not confirmed until your deposit is received.

Friday, July 17, 2026 (MBS, L)

Get ready for a day exploring Detroit's beautiful art & architecture! You will board the motorcoach in the morning for a short ride to our first stop, a restroom and breakfast break. Grab a few goodies for the road and climb back on board!

You will arrive at the **Detroit Institute of Arts** where you will have over an hour to explore on your own. Depart the museum for a tour of the **Fisher Building**, a landmark skyscraper in the heart of the New Center area of Detroit. Lunch will be served at the deliciously authentic **Vincente's Cuban Cuisine**. Next up is a narrated city tour aboard the motorcoach ending at the **Guardian Building**. You will then take a tour inside this beautiful Art Deco skyscraper in Detroit's Financial District. A short walk across the street gets you to **Spirit Plaza** and your next destination. This 20,000 square foot civic square is a great place to take a stroll and view the famous Spirit of Detroit bronze statue and "The Fist" monument to Joe Louis. The **Renaissance Center** or "RenCen" is another short walk away and is an example of the 1970s urban renewal of Downtown Detroit. A dinner stop will be made in Brighton on the way home where several fast food options are available.
