### Reservations & Payment Schedule:

**Single-day tours** \$199 and under: full payment is due at time of reservation.

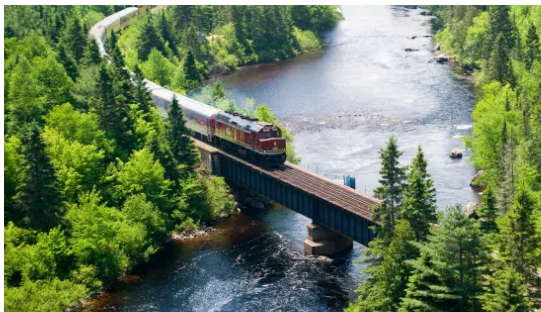

**Brief Itinerary:**

**Day 1: Saturday, August 1 - MBS, D**

Board the motorcoach for adventure up North! Our signature breakfast to-go will be served along the way. You will arrive in **Sault Ste. Marie** in time for exploring and lunch on your own before departing for a **boat ride on the St. Mary's River and through the Soo Locks**. You will then head into Canada to your hotel for the night where a buffet dinner will be served.

**Day 2: Sunday, August 2 - CB, L**

Rise & shine and get ready for breakfast on the **Agawa Canyon Train Tour!** Sit back, relax on this day long adventure viewing the beautiful landscape of Ontario, Canada. Lunch will also be served aboard the train. When your train adventure ends you will head back towards the hotel for a night on your own.

**Day 3: Monday, August 3 - CB, D**

Breakfast is served at the hotel this morning before you depart for the beautiful **Tahquamenon Falls** to explore and enjoy lunch on your own! Enjoy lunch on your own before departing for beautiful **Copper Harbor** where you will visit **Fort Wilkins**, and have dinner on your own. We will take the scenic **Brockway Mountain Drive**, known for its panoramic views of Lake Superior and the surrounding forests, on our way back to our hotel for the night.

Grab breakfast at the hotel then head out to the Porcupine Mountains and the breathtaking views at the **Lake of the Clouds Overlook**. You will depart for **Marquette**, stopping for lunch en route.
