Brief Itinerary:

Day 1: Monday, November 9 or 16 (SB, D)

You will depart this morning for your Nashville adventure, beginning with a stop for our signature breakfast to-go bag. The majority of this day will be spent driving to Nashville, stopping for dinner at **Paula Deen's Family Kitchen** upon arrival. Following dinner, you'll be joined by a **successful local songwriter**. He'll play some of the hit songs he's written and answer questions about the recording industry before we check into our hotel for the night.

Day 2: Tuesday, November 10 or 17 (HB, D)

This morning will begin with a hot breakfast at your hotel before you head to your **professionally guided tour of Nashville**. Following the tour, you will have time to explore the **historic 2nd Avenue (downtown Nashville)** for shopping and lunch on your own. Dinner this evening will be served at the **Santa Fe Cattle Company**. Following dinner, you will experience a show at the **Grand Ole Opry** before heading back to our hotel.

Day 3: Wednesday, November 11 or 18 (HB, L, D)
