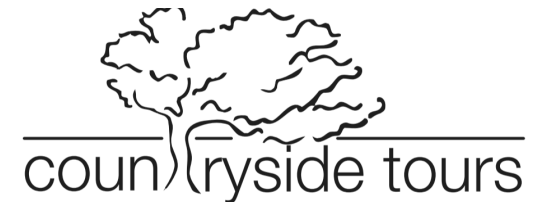

## Brief Itinerary

### Day 1: Monday, May 4 - MBS, D

Your motorcoach adventure starts today! You will stop for our signature breakfast to-go bags and a restroom break. A lunch stop will also be made during the day for you to grab something on your own. Next, stop at the **Kentucky Artisan Center**. Your destination tonight is **Boone Tavern** in Berea, Kentucky. A buffet dinner will be served up after check in.

### Day 2: Tuesday, May 5 - CB, D

Enjoy a freshly prepared breakfast before exploring the artisan town of **Berea, Kentucky**. You will have several hours to wander **College Square** (downtown area and surrounding campus of Berea College, known for its arts and crafts scene), have lunch on your own, and **Old Town Artisan Village** (the district with independent shops, galleries, and restaurants.) From there you will ride into **Asheville**. Dinner will be served at **The Red Rocker**. You will check into the **Hilton** to stay for the next 3 nights.

### Day 3: Wednesday, May 6 - CB, L

Start your morning off with a fresh breakfast served in our private dining room. After you are fueled up spend the day touring **Asheville** and the **Blue Ridge Mountains** with a **local guide**. Lunch is included during your adventures, dinner will be on your own at a local restaurant.
