### Reservations & Payment Schedule:

**Single-day tours** \$199 and under: full payment is due at time of reservation.

**Single-day tours** \$200+: \$100 deposit, final payment due 45 days prior to tour.

**Multi-day tours:** \$100 deposit due at reservation, 50% of balance is due 90 days prior to the tour, with final payment due 45 days prior the tour.

Deposits are non refundable. Payments become non-refundable upon due dates. Travelers can fill their vacancy or forfeit their monies. In the event of a cancelation, both of the travelers must contact the office to fill a vacancy.

Reservations can may be at online, by phone, or with the reservation coupon. Deposits are due at the time of reservation. Your reservation is not confirmed until your deposit is received.
