### Reservations & Payment Schedule:

**Single-day tours** \$199 and under: full payment is due at time of reservation.

**Single-day tours** \$200+: \$100 deposit, final payment due 45 days prior to tour.

Deposits are non refundable. Final payments become non-refundable upon due dates. Travelers can fill their vacancy or forfeit their monies. In the event of a cancelation, both the travelers must contact the office to fill a vacancy.
