Reservations & Payment Schedule:

Single-day tours \$199 and under: full payment is due at time of reservation.

Single-day tours \$200+: \$100 deposit, final payment due 45 days prior to tour.

Multi-day tours: \$100 deposit due at reservation, 50% of balance is due 90 days prior to the tour, with final payment due 45 days prior the tour.

Tours may require a larger deposit due to tour expenses and will be noted on the brochure.

Deposits are non refundable. Payments become non-refundable upon due dates. Travelers can fill their vacancy or forfeit their monies. In the event of a cancelation, both of the travelers must contact the office to fill a vacancy.

Reservations can may be at online, by phone, or with the reservation coupon. Deposits are due at the time of reservation. Your reservation is not confirmed until your deposit is received.

Countryside Tours, Inc. reserves the right to cancel a tour due to insufficient participation. In this case, complete refund of monies will be made. Any refunds needed for those who pay via credit cards will be made by a Countryside Tours check, minus 3% processing fees.

Brief Itinerary:

Day 1: Tuesday, June 23 (SB)

Continue the journey north with a stop for lunch on your own at **Mackinaw Crossings**, offering a variety of dining options. This afternoon, cross into the Upper Peninsula and visit **Ben Franklin** for more shopping before heading to **Escanaba**. This evening, check in at the **Comfort Suites Escanaba** and relax after a full day of quilting inspiration.

Day 2: Wednesday, June 24 (HB)

Begin your morning with breakfast at the hotel. Travel a short distance to **Tebear**, then continue on to **Miss Good Stitch**, where you'll enjoy time to shop, have lunch on your own, and explore the charming surrounding town. This afternoon, take in the natural beauty of **Horseshoe Falls**, followed by free time to choose between a visit to **Kewadin Casino** or rock hunting along the Lake Superior Shoreline at Bay Furnace Ruins. 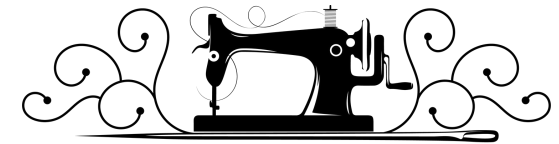
Day 4: Friday, June 26 (HB)
