### Reservations & Payment Schedule:

**Single-day tours** \$199 and under: full payment is due at time of reservation.

### Day 9: Wednesday, September 30 (HB)

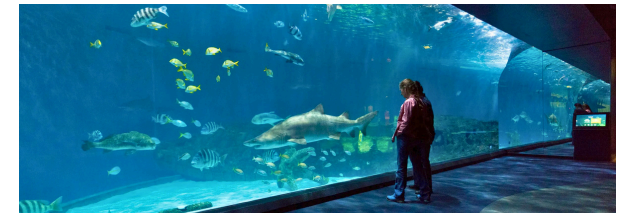
