

Itinerary-

Day 1 - June 10, 2027 - Thursday - D

We'll depart Our Lady of Consolation school parking lot at 5:30 am this morning for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We will stop at the Cleveland Zoo for some lunch (on own) and time to stretch our legs before heading to our hotel in New York for the night.

Day 2 - June 11, 2027 - Friday - CB, L, & D

An early start this morning will find us heading east to Boston. After lunch at Quincy Market Place we take a tour of the famous Fenway Park, home of the Boston Red Sox. We then board the "Duck", a W.W.II-style, amphibious landing vehicle, and cruise by all places that make Boston the Birthplace of Freedom. Our dinner will be at the Fire & Ice Grill, where you choose your own ingredients and then watch their Grill Chefs create your meal on the world's largest grill. We then head south towards New York City for the night.

Day 3 - June 12, 2027 - Saturday - CB, L, & D

This is a day of exploring the "Big Apple". Our morning will start with a 60-second elevator ride to the 100th floor, for breathtaking views of NYC at One World Observatory. Next we head to the 9/11 Memorial Museum, where we will learn of the events, the aftermath and continuing implications of September 11, 2001. After lunch, we will then take a heart-stopping thrill ride aboard The Beast, out to see the Statue of Liberty. Next, we will head to Times Square to experience RiseNY where we will see the city up close as we soar through it. Last, we will grab dinner at Bubba Gump Shrimp Co. before head south for Washington D.C..

Day 4 - June 13, 2027 - Sunday - CB, L, & D

We will depart for Washington D.C. to spend the afternoon exploring the Smithsonian Museums. After some dinner we will take a guided tour of our nation's memorials before heading to our hotel for the night.

Day 5 - June 14, 2027 - Monday - CB, L, & D

After breakfast at the hotel we will take a tram ride through Arlington Cemetery for the Changing of the Guard Ceremony. We will have time for lunch and shopping at the Fashion Centre at Pentagon City Mall before we head for Gettysburg. We will visit the Beyond the Battlefield Museum before heading to dinner. Lastly, we will tour downtown Gettysburg and further learn about the events that happened in those very spots, then head to our hotel for the night.

Day 6 - June 15, 2027 - Tuesday - CB, L, & D

This morning will be spent touring the Gettysburg National Military Park with a Park Service Guide, and visit the Shriver House, where we will learn what it was like to be a civilian during the Battle of Gettysburg. This afternoon and evening, we'll enjoy the amusement rides at Hershey Park! Afterwards, we will reboard our motorcoach and head for home.

Day 7 - June 16, 2027 - Wednesday

We will arrive back in West Michigan around 8:30 am.

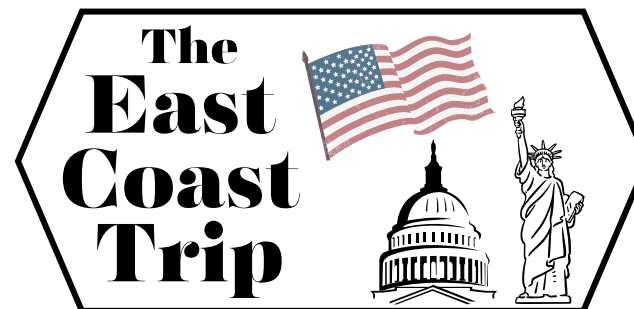

Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments: Reservations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis with a deposit of \$100.00 made payable to Countryside Tours, Inc. Late payments will be assessed a penalty of \$25.00.

Insufficient Fund Checks: There will be a \$30.00 charge for checks with insufficient funds.

Tour Cost: The tour cost as advertised in this brochure is based on current costs and tariffs in effect at the time of printing. Should these change, an adjustment (either way) will result. If the advertised tour cost is increased by more than 5%, you may cancel within 10 days of notification and receive a full refund.

Cancellations and Refunds: Cancellations MUST be made in writing (email is acceptable) to our office. For cancellations on or prior to the March payment deadline there will be a full refund less an administrative fee of \$50.00. For cancellations received after that date there will be no refund of the \$100.00 deposit.
