Day 1 - May 8, 2027 - Saturday

We will depart Grandville Middle School parking lot at 8:00 pm this evening for our exciting adventure.

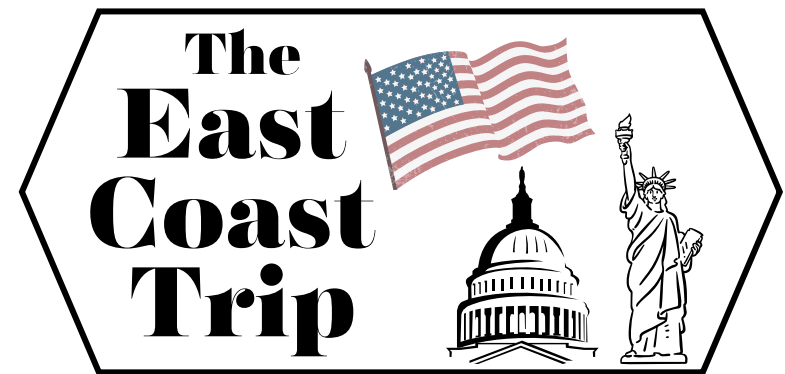
