

Itinerary-

Day 1 - June 16, 2027 - Wednesday - D

We'll depart Cedar Springs Middle School at 5:30 am this morning for our exciting tour to the East Coast and Washington D.C.! We will stop at the Cleveland Zoo for some lunch (on own) and time to stretch our legs before heading to Gettysburg for the night. Once we arrive we will get dinner at the Farmhouse Restaurant before taking a guided walking tour through the haunted downtown Gettysburg.

Day 2 - June 17, 2027 - Thursday - CB, L, & D

This morning will be spent touring the Gettysburg National Military Park with a Park Service Guide. We will then hit the visitors center to see the Civil War Film and Cyclorama before doing some souvineer shopping. After lunch, we will hop on the bus and head for Washington DC. When we arrive we will visit the White House, the People's House Museum, and the Capitol Building. Lastly, we will board a dinner cruise down the Potomac river before heading to our hotel for the night.

Day 3 - June 18, 2027 - Friday - B, L, & D

Today we start with a tram ride through Arlington National Cemetery for the Changing of the Guard Ceremony. We will have time for shopping and lunch at the Pentagon Mall before heading for the Smithsonian Museums where we will spend the afternoon. After dinner at the Hard Rock Cafe, we will take a guided walking tour of our nations memorials, before heading back to our hotel.

Day 4 - June 19, 2027 - Saturday - CB, L, & D

We will start our day with a drive to Philadelphia. Once we arrive we will take a ride on a double-decker bus through the historic streets of Philadelphia. The ride will end at the National Constitution Center where we will see the Freedom Rising show. Following some lunch, we will take a walk through Independence National Historical Park to see Independence Hall and Liberty Bell. We then head to New York City for heart-stopping thrill ride aboard The Beast, out to see the Statue of Liberty. We will end the evening with dinner before heading to the hotel.

Day 5 - June 20, 2027 - Sunday - CB, L, & D

Today will be spent exploring the "Big Apple". Our morning will start with a visit to the 9/11 Memorial Museum, where we will learn of the events, the aftermath and continuing implications of September 11, 2001. We will then take a 60-second elevator ride to the 100th floor, for breathtaking views of NYC at One World Observatory before having some lunch. Our afternoon will be spent on a Central Park Walking Tour. We will end our explorations of NYC in Times Square where we will experience New York City's ultimate immersive adventure - featuring a 4D soaring flyover ride. Lastly, we will have dinner at Bubba Gump Shrimp Company before boarding the buses and heading to the hotel.

Day 6 - June 21, 2027 - Monday - CB, L, & D

Today, we head for Hershey Park! We'll enjoy the amusement rides, games, and the waterpark. Afterwards, we will reboard our motorcoach and head for home.

Day 7 - June 22, 2027 - Tuesday

We will arrive back in West Michigan.

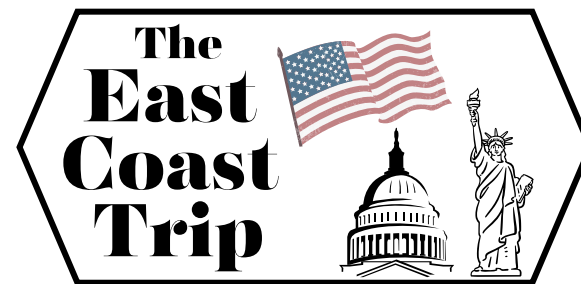

Reservations, Deposits, Final Payments: Reservations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis with a deposit of \$100.00 made payable to Countryside Tours, Inc. Reservation coupon and check must be sent to Countryside Tours, Inc., P.O. Box 48, Sand Lake, Michigan 49343-0048. Final payment will be due on, or prior to, March 31, 2027. Late payments will be assessed a penalty of \$25.00.

Insufficient Fund Checks: There will be a \$30.00 charge for checks with insufficient funds.

Tour Cost: The tour cost as advertised in this brochure is based on current costs and tariffs in effect at the time of printing. Should these change, an adjustment (either way) will result. If the advertised tour cost is increased by more than 5%, you may cancel within 10 days of notification and receive a full refund.

Cancellations and Refunds: Cancellations MUST be made in writing (email is acceptable) to our office. For cancellations on or prior to the March payment deadline there will be a full refund less an administrative fee of \$50.00.
